ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING SECTION 25, ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 62 SERIES OF 2007 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MARIKINA VETERINARY CODE OF 2007

WHEREAS, presented to the 9th City Council for appropriate action is the January 24, 2022 letter of Dr. Manuel C. Carlos, Consultant of the Marikina City Veterinary Office, addressed to Hon. Vice-Mayor Marion S. Andres, M.D., requesting for the suspension of registration fees of cats and dogs as stipulated in Section 25, Article I, Chapter 4 of Ordinance No. 62, Series of 2007, otherwise known as the Marikina Veterinary Code of 2007;

WHEREAS, as a justification, the City Veterinary Office says that COVID-19 pandemic continues to adversely affect pet dog and cat owners and are rightly concerned about the negative impact of the pandemic on their financial lives;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Ways and Means to which the matter was referred sought the advice and recommendation thereon of the City Finance Committee as contained in its Committee Report No. 21-166 dated February 9, 2022;

WHEREAS, the City Finance Committee, in turn, promptly submitted its recommendation contained in its February 10 letter-reply to the Committee on Ways and Means stating, among others, that it endorses the "temporary suspension of the registration of fees which is explicitly provided in the aforesaid section of the "Marikina Veterinary Code of 2007", and agreeing therein with the reasons of said suspension as mentioned in the February 10 letter of Dr. Manuel C. Carlos to the City Finance Committee;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Ways and Means favorably adopts the aforesaid recommendation and, as such, the request of the City Veterinary Office be granted and be contained in an Ordinance;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act (RA) No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom x x x and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, x x x maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;"

WHEREAS, upon review, this August Body finds the request meritorious, in order, and within the bounds of law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG MARIKINA, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Section 25 of Article I, Chapter 4 of Ordinance No. 62 Series of 2007 Otherwise known as the Marikina Code of 2007, pertaining to registration of dogs and cats hereunder quoted in part is hereby temporarily suspended until April 30, 2022:

“Section 25. Dog and Cats Registration. *It shall be unlawful for any person to own, keep or have control of a dog without having obtained a registration for such animal, the primary purpose of which is the control and prevention of animal disease particularly rabies.*

- c. *The requirements for dog and cat registration shall be as follows:*
 - i. *For first time registrants:*

- ii. *Requirements upon annual renewal of registration:*

 - >*Proofs of vaccination for the previous year. For failure to present such proofs, a fine of*
One hundred Pesos (P100.00) shall be charged in addition to the renewal fee xxx”

SECTION 2. Separability Clause.- If any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions herof which are not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Repealing Clause.- All ordinances and administrative regulations or part/s thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.


SECTION 4. Effectivity.- This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


