ORDINANCE REQUIRING PUBLIC TRANSPORT PLYING IN MARIKINA CITY AND LOCAL ESTABLISHMENTS TO PROVIDE ALCOHOL OR HAND SANITIZER FOR THEIR COMMUTERS AND CUSTOMERS, RESPECTIVELY

WHEREAS, we live in the midst of perilous situation that entails collective efforts to effectively address the threats of coronavirus disease (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon every town or city to think of ways, big or small, to support the national efforts at mitigating the spread of the aforesaid virus in our country and in our community, in particular;

WHEREAS, it is believed that every measure meant to hurdle the challenge unfolding in our midst is crucial because life is precious;

WHEREAS, it is in this light that our city has taken cognizance of the importance of requiring public transport and local establishments to provide alcohol or hand sanitizer to protect their passengers and patrons, respectively.)

WHEREAS, concerned instrumentalities of the local government should conduct regular inspection of said public transport and establishments to ensure their compliance,)

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (5) (xii) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall—

“ xxx Approve measures and adopt quarantine regulations to prevent the introduction and spread of disease ”;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD of MARIKINA, in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. The City Government of Marikina hereby requires all public transportations plying in Marikina City and all local establishments catering to clients to provide alcohol or hand sanitizer for their commuters and customers, respectively to decrease the risk of spreading infection or viruses.

SECTION 2. *Scope and Coverage.* This Ordinance shall cover all public transportations and business establishments in Marikina City especially those that are catering to clientele.

SECTION 3. *Definition of Terms.* For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms are hereby defined or described:

- a. Public Transportation – shall refer to tricycles, jeepneys, public utility vehicles (PUVs), transport network vehicle services (TNVS), and the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines (OFG) compliant units;
- b. Business Establishment – is defined as a location where business is conducted, goods are made or stored or processed or where services are rendered.

SECTION 4. *Implementing Agencies.* The Office of Public Safety and Security, the Business Permits and Licensing Office and the City Health Office will be in charge of effectively implementing this ordinance.

SECTION 5. *Penalty Clause.* Any person, owner, operator who shall be found violating this ordinance shall be meted the following penalties:

First Offense	-	Warning
Second Offense	-	Five Hundred Pesos (₱500.00)
Third Offense	-	One Thousand Pesos (₱1,000.00)
Succeeding Offenses	-	Three Thousand Pesos (₱3,000.00)


SECTION 6. *Effectivity.* This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
