**ORDINANCE EXEMPTING SHOE AND LEATHERGOODS RETAILERS OF THE PHILIPPINE FOOTWEAR FEDERATION INCORPORATED (PFFI) FROM PAYMENT OF RENTAL FEES, INCLUDING ELECTRICITY CHARGES, FOR THE USE OF STALLS ON THE GROUND FLOOR OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT-OWNED MULTI-LEVEL PARKING BUILDING FROM NOVEMBER 2023 TO JANUARY 2024**

**WHEREAS**, during its 47th Regular Session, the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Marikina has considered the request made by the Philippine Footwear Federation, Incorporated (PFFI) in their letter dated September 13, 2023, seeking permission to hold the Christmas Shoe Bazaar on the ground floor of the Multi-Level Parking Building from November 2023 to January 2024;

**WHEREAS**, exempting Philippine Footwear Federation, Incorporated (PFFI) from paying rental fees for the use of these stalls could provide necessary relief and help mitigate the adverse consequences of economic downturns especially during the COVID-19 period which had caused the non-operation of their businesses and unforeseen financial hardships;

**WHEREAS**, in order to foster a sense of community and pride and for people to recognize and appreciate the talents of local shoemakers and leathercraft artisans as well as the rich heritage and history of the city in shoemaking and crafting of leather products, the stalls shall exclusively display for sale local shoe products and leathergoods;

**WHEREAS**, Section 192 of Republic Act No. 7160, known as the Local Government Code 1991 which empowers local government units the authority to grant tax exemption privileges states:

*Local government units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, incentives or reliefs under such terms and conditions, as they may deem necessary.*

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF MARIKINA CITY**, in regular session assembled, that:

**SECTION 1. Exemption from Payment of Rental Fees and Electricity Consumption.-** Shoe and leathersgoods retailers of PFFI are hereby granted an exemption from paying rental fees, including electricity charges, for the use of stalls on the ground floor of the city government-owned Multi-Level Parking Building from November 2023 to January 2024.

**SECTION 2. Terms and Conditions.-** PFFI shall comply with all other city ordinances, applicable and relevant laws, rules and regulations governing public events, commercial or business operations and market activities. The exemption provided herein shall be subject to any additional terms and conditions deemed necessary by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Marikina.

**SECTION 3. Repealing Clause.-** All local ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof that are inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 4. Separability Clause.-** The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be separable and, if any clause, sentence or provision or section of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances should for any reason be held invalid by a competent court, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or application of the Ordinance.


