ORDINANCE RE-IMPOSING A THREE (3) YEAR MORATORIUM ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FUNERAL HOMES IN MARIKINA CITY

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2016, the 7th City council of Marikina enacted Ordinance No. 076 Series of 2015 entitled: "Ordinance Imposing a Three (3) year Moratorium on the establishment of Funeral Homes in Marikina City" for the purpose of regulating the establishment of new funeral homes in the city;

WHEREAS, in this light, there is a need for a re-imposition of the moratorium on the aforementioned establishment in Marikina City for the same reason as stated in Ordinance No. 076, Series of 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARIKINA in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. A moratorium of three (3) years commencing on April 2020 until April 2022 is hereby declared on the establishment of funeral homes in Marikina City and shall remain in full force and effect until lifted by the City Council through a subsequent ordinance.

SECTION 2. During the time the temporary moratorium is in effect, the City Government of Marikina shall not accept any application or act on any pending applications for business permits or licenses for the establishment or operation of funeral homes in Marikina City.

SECTION 3. Let a copy of this Ordinance be furnished the City Engineering Office, Business Permit and Licensing Office, City Planning Office and other concerned offices for their information and guidance.

SECTION 4. If any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared null and void, other parts or provisions not so affected shall remain valid and effective.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
