ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 015 SERIES OF 2020 ENTITLED "ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING A PUBLIC HEALTH CURFEW IN THE CITY OF MARIKINA TO CONTAIN THE SPREAD OF THE CORONA VIRUS DISEASE (COVID-2019)"

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 15, Series of 2020 explicitly provides in part that "*Curfew Hours - means hours prohibiting any person, subject of this Ordinance, to remain or stay in public places from eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 PM) to five o'clock in the morning (5:00 AM) of the following day*";

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the same Ordinance partly stipulates that "*the public is hereby prohibited to loiter, wander, stroll, play or to remain or stay in public places within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Marikina without exempting or justifiable reason from eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 PM) to five o'clock in the morning (5:00 AM) of the following day, daily, save those falling under herein exceptions*";

WHEREAS, Section 5 thereof also provides the following:

SECTION 5. Exemptions. - *The following persons, acts or occasions, shall be exempted from the implementation of this Ordinance:*

- a) *Health Workers and Frontline Personnel in the performance of their functions;*

- b) *On duty Police, Military personnel and other Law Enforcement Officer;*
- c) *Any National or City Official or Employee in the performance of their duties;*
- d) *Public and Private employees who are returning from work, provided that they present their identification cards and certification of their official office hours;*
- e) *Those who provide public transport services (bus, tricycles, TNVS, jeepney drivers);*
- f) *Those who provide delivery services for basic necessities such as food and medicines;*
- g) *Employees of utility companies;*
- h) *Any person involved in an emergency situation, requiring immediate action to safeguard, protect or preserve his or another's life, limb, or property;*
- i) *Any person that will be issued a Certificate of Exception by the Office of the City Mayor."*

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE 9TH CITY COUNCIL, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Section 2 (c) of Ordinance No. 015 Series of 2020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Curfew Hours- means hours prohibiting any person, subject of this Ordinance, to remain or stay in public places from ten o'clock in the evening (10:00 PM) to five o'clock in the morning (5:00 AM) of the following day";

SECTION 2. First paragraph of Section 3 thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. Prohibited Acts. - The public is hereby prohibited to loiter, wander, stroll, play or to remain or stay in public places within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Marikina without exempting or justifiable reason from ten o'clock in the evening (10:00PM) to five o'clock in the morning (5:00AM) of the following day, daily, save those falling under herein exceptions";

SECTION 3. Section 5 of the same Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5. Exemptions. - The following persons, acts or occasions, shall be exempted from the implementation of this Ordinance:


- a) *Health Workers and Frontline Personnel in the performance of their functions;*
- b) *On duty Police, Military personnel and other Law Enforcement Officer;*
- c) *Any National or City Official or Employee in the performance of their duties;*
- d) *Public and Private employees who are returning from work, provided that they present their identification cards;*
- e) *Those who provide public transport services (bus, tricycles, TNVS, jeepney drivers);*

- f) *Those who provide delivery services for basic necessities such as food and medicines;*
- g) *Employees of utility companies;*
- h) *Workers or wage earners from key establishments like dine-in restaurants and convenience stores whose work schedule is within the stipulated curfew hours from 10:00 PM - 5:00 AM;*
- i) *Patrons and customers of dine-in restaurants and convenience stores provided that they have to strictly observe physical distancing, wearing of face masks and other safety and health standards and protocols imposed by the national government and the city government;*
- j) *Any person involved in an emergency situation, requiring immediate action to safeguard, protect or preserve his or another's life, limb, or property;*
- k) *Any person that will be issued a Certificate of Exception by the Chairperson of the Local IATF."*

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


